6127	Spisordning för Coopvaerdie sjöfolk 1759.	Ca 320×195 mm.
6176	Johan Fredrik Martins Svenska Vuer med 48 planscher (2 volymer).	Proveniens: Gustaf Trolle-Bonde (1773-1855), den blinde excellensen på Säfstaholms slott.
6195A	Rentz rare Todten-tantz (Dance of Death) in first edition printed in 1741.	Text not printed from copperplates -as earlier stated - but calligraphed with contemporary ink.
6210	Blaeu's fine set with world map and the four continents, ca 1640, 5 maps.	All maps with centrefolds as issued. America with lower part of centrefold slightly worn. Some slight spotting.
