According to the provisions of Law 16/1985, of June 25, of the Spanish Historical Heritage, some of the Lots included in the auctions require, in order to leave Spanish territory, the prior express authorization of the State Administration and, for therefore, compliance with the requirements indicated in this standard must be met. For exports outside the European Union, the payment of fees for customs will be paid by the Buyer.

The procedures of the export license are initiated once the purchase invoice has been paid. No lot may be delivered to the Buyer until the license has been granted by the Ministry. In case the Purchaser has managed the license himself, he must present the document to be able to withdraw the lot.
